4. What will be an opportunity for the City Manager to be a part of or create in their first 6 months on the job?
5. What will be the biggest challenge for them in the 1-2 year period?
6. If the City Manager could only accomplish one thing in their first year, what would you like that to be?
7. Economically – if “it” went away, what would have the largest impact on the City? The second largest?

8. What organizations should the City partner with to create a more economically sound community that serves all of the population? How strong is that relationship now?
9. How well do you think the City does in following its mission and/or strategic plan?
10. Is there anything “politically” that could create difficulties in recruiting for the next City Manager?
11. What is the largest financial challenge for the City?
