AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF BETHEL FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, as follows:

SECTION 1. Classification. This is a non-codified Ordinance and shall not become part of the Bethel Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. Fiscal Year Budget Amendments. The following estimated revenues and expenditures are hereby appropriated for the corporate purposes and objects of the City of Bethel for Fiscal Year 2020.

WHEREAS, the City's Recruitment Firm has identified two applicants for City Manager and potentially three applicants for City Attorney;

WHEREAS, the Council will hold onsite interviews with each candidate in October;

WHEREAS, the City will be responsible for flight and accommodations for the applicants and is interested in providing reasonable flight and accommodations for the spouse of each applicant;
